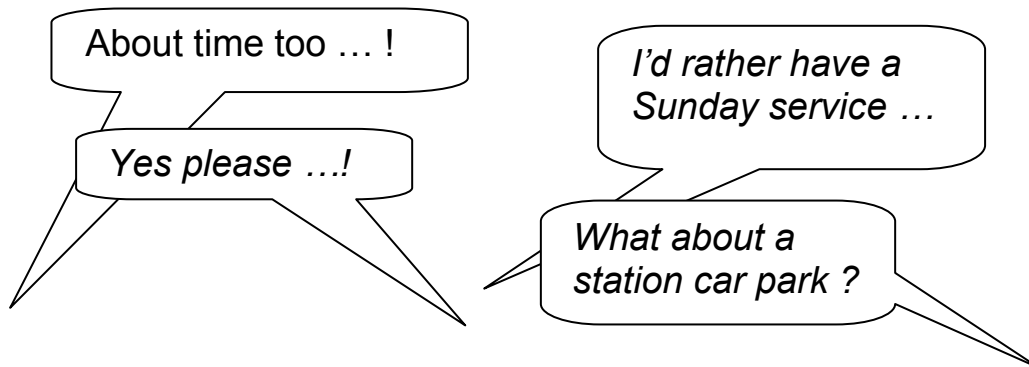


What would you say to more seats on trains from Walkden ?

GMPTE are running a massive public consultation exercise about the “TIF” plan to invest £3bn into Manchester’s transport system, partly funded by peak-time congestion charging on roads into the city.

Modest improvements for Walkden station are included, but FOWS believe they don’t go far enough. New signs, CCTV and Passenger Information Systems will all be welcome, but with more and more people using the station, the need for longer trains, a car park, and disabled access is critical.

We urge all station users to take part in GMPTE’s consultation in order to get the best possible deal for Walkden.
